With a population exceeding 500,000, Stanislaus County is proud of its vibrant citizenry, great traditions, educational opportunities, and multicultural lifestyles. Stanislaus County is one of the largest employers in Stanislaus County with approximately 3,700 individuals dedicated to public service. The Director of Planning & Community Development is a Department Head position responsible for overseeing department operations, which included a budget of approximately \$31.5 million and 29 full-time staff in Fiscal Year 2011-2012. The position serves as Executive Director to the Stanislaus County Planning Commission as well as provides leadership to the Airport Land Use Commission, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, and the Stanislaus County Redevelopment Agency (Successor Agency as of February 1, 2012). The Department includes five Divisions: Planning, Community Development, Building Permits, Administration and Finance. Requirements include a Bachelor's degree or equivalent in planning, public administration, geography or a related field and five (5) years of administrative, managerial, or supervising experience in a professional public sector planning setting.
